After breakfast, depart for Bloukrans Bridge, home to Bloukrans Bungee — proudly holding the Guinness World Record for the Highest Commercial Bungee Jump in the world at 216 meters. The bungee jump is available as an optional activity. Afterwards, continue to visit Tsitsikamma National Park, located on the southeastern coast of Africa along the beautiful shores of Algoa Bay. This major sea port and popular tourist destination features an 80 km long coastal strip between Nature's Valley and the mouth of the Storms River

As South Africa's most photographed landmark, the mountain draws millions who ascend its summit via the famous cableway. Enjoy a scenic ride in the rotating cable car to the top of Table Mountain for breathtaking views over the city and the surrounding coastline.

Cape Town's elegant historic buildings offer a glimpse into its rich and varied past. You will visit the **Castle of Good Hope**, the oldest standing colonial structure in the country. Just a short walk away lies **City Hall**, an ornate Edwardian-style building completed in 1905, located across from the **Grand Parade**.

As we continue along **Adderley Street**, Cape Town's main thoroughfare, we pass **St. George's Cathedral**, the seat of the Anglican Church and closely associated with Nobel Peace Prize winner Archbishop Desmond Tutu. Next catch a glimpse of the **Company's Garden**, a tranquil and lush retreat in the heart of the city. We then explore the vibrant and historic **Bo-Kaap (Malay Quarter)**, passing landmarks like the **South African Museum** and various other notable sites. We stopped at the **V & A Waterfront** – South Africa's most popular visitor destination, bustling with shops, dining options and entertainment. the harbour to continue exploring at your leisure. Return transport from the V&A Waterfront to your hotel will then be on your own
