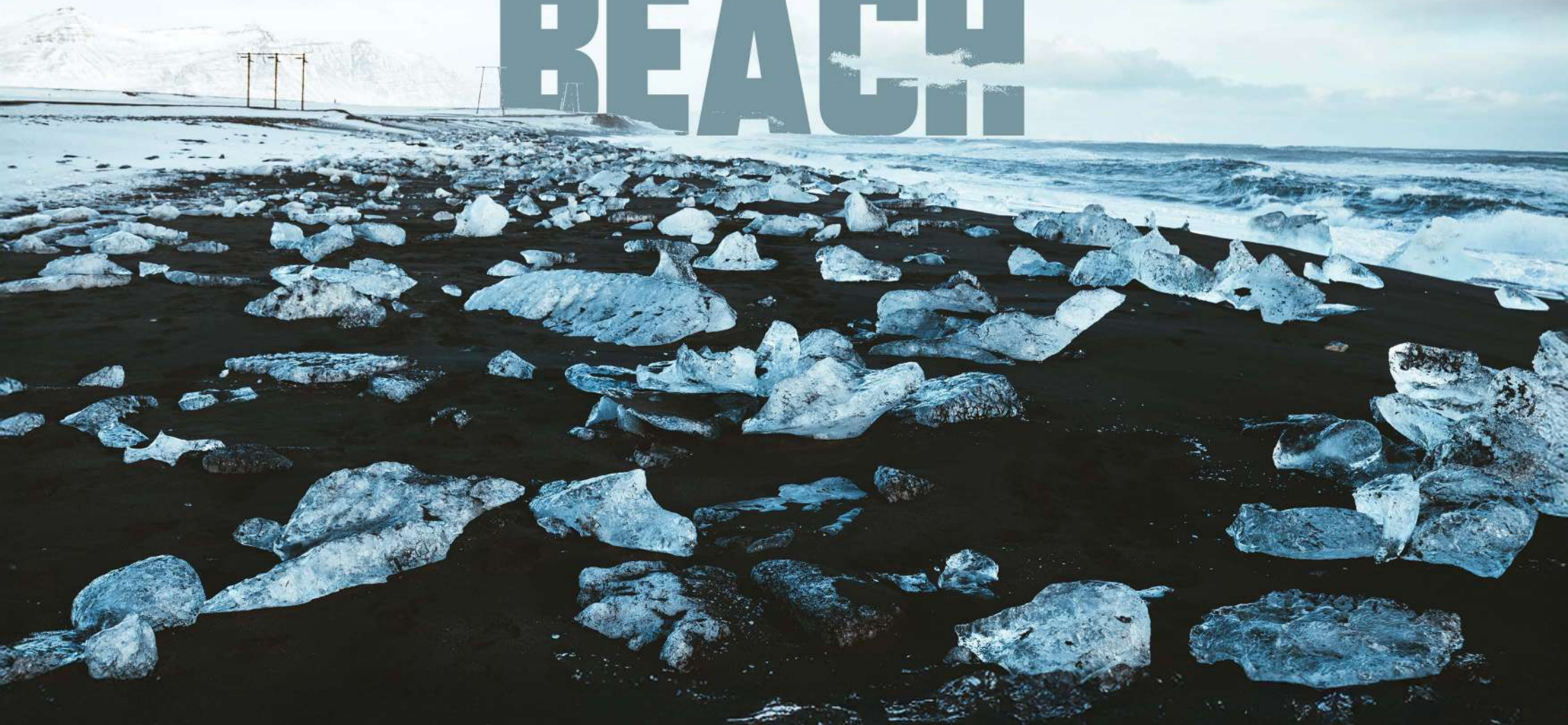
DAY 8

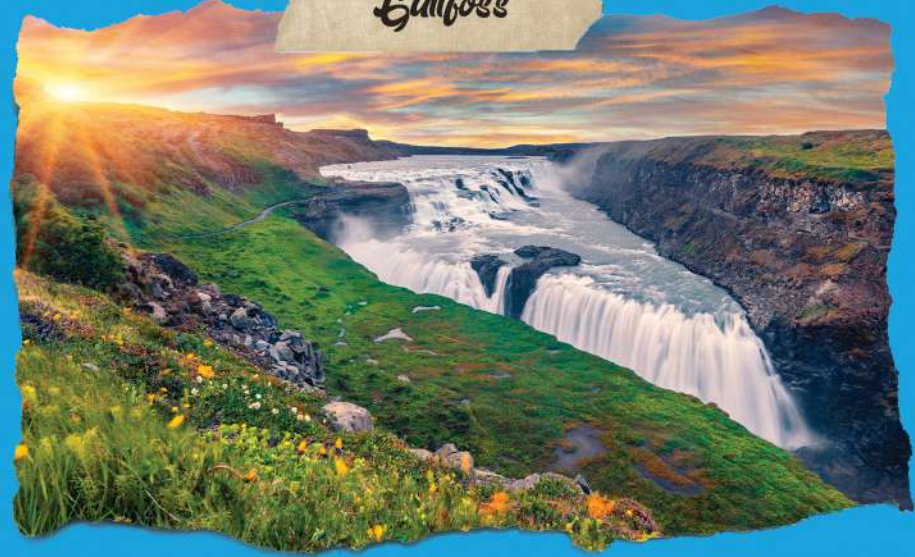
DAY 9

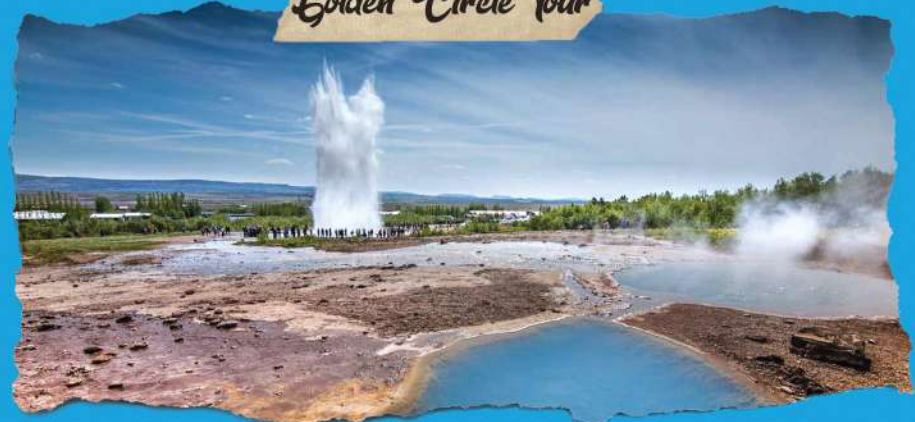

IMPORTANT NOTES

- > It is understood by the clients that the hotels in Iceland are usually NOT centrally located and are tourist class hotels and does not have Air conditions and Fans in their room due to cold weather conditions.
- > Hotel check-in time is 15:00 hrs. And check-out time is 11:00 hrs. Early check-in and late check-out are not guaranteed.
- > As per European regulations, the third or fourth person will need to book a separate room.
- > We use air-conditioned or air-cooled luxury coaches. To ensure fairness, daily seat rotation will be implemented, and seats are not pre-assigned.
- > Due to unpredictable weather caused by global warming, coach cooling may take time, which is beyond our control.
- > Deviations or changes during the tour are not allowed.
- > Coaches will stop only at designated points, and according to their schedule. Coaches are not provided for shopping trips. The coach driver is limited to driving for 10 hours a day;
- > Any damages caused by you or your family members to the coach during the tour must be paid for by you, and Velvet Vacations will not be responsible for such damages.
- > If the requested hotel is unavailable, we will try to book a similar hotel at the same price point.
- > If you decide to return to India for any reason during the trip, all costs associated with the return will be the responsibility of the passenger, and no re-funds will be provided.
- > If you book your own flights that do not align with the group's departure and arrival times, you will need to arrange and cover the cost of your own airport transfers to and from the hotel.

- > The Journeys may be longer as we cover different countries by coaches.
- > An extra bed or triple occupant requested in same room will be Roll-Away Bed depending on hotel.
- > The drivers have to follow Iceland Rules and Regulations and cannot exceed their driving hours, so the passengers are advised to follow instructions for the timings given by the Tour Leader.
- > Limited varieties of Breakfast will be served by the hotel, however wherever possible we will try to provide. additional one item of Indian dish along with Masala Tea.
- > Tap Water is safe to drink so it is advisable to carry empty bottle from India.

NECESSARY INFORMATION

- > There is no portage facility at the airport/hotel, hence it is advisable to carry a lightweight bag having trolleys.
- > The itinerary can be shuffled or changed at any given point of time in the interest of the group.
- > There will NOT be any luggage handling facility throughout the tour in motor coach, hotels, and airport; passengers will have to handle their own luggage.
- > Passengers having excess baggage of more than 20 kg check-in baggage are liable to pay excess baggage charge directly to the airport and airline authorities. Hand luggage of 7 kg per person is allowed.
- > The temperature in Europe during April to June averages 15 to 20 degrees. One jacket / sweater is recommended for this kind of weather. Heavy warm clothing is not required.

Velvet Vacations will not be held responsible for any visa rejections by any consulate or embassy. Additionally, in case of visa rejection, the client is required to pay the visa fees again. - > A non-negotiable and mandatory 5% GST and 2% TCS will be applicable. For bookings under 7 lakhs, 2% TCS applies, while bookings of 7 lakhs and above require a 20% TCS payment.

TRANSPORT & TRANSFER

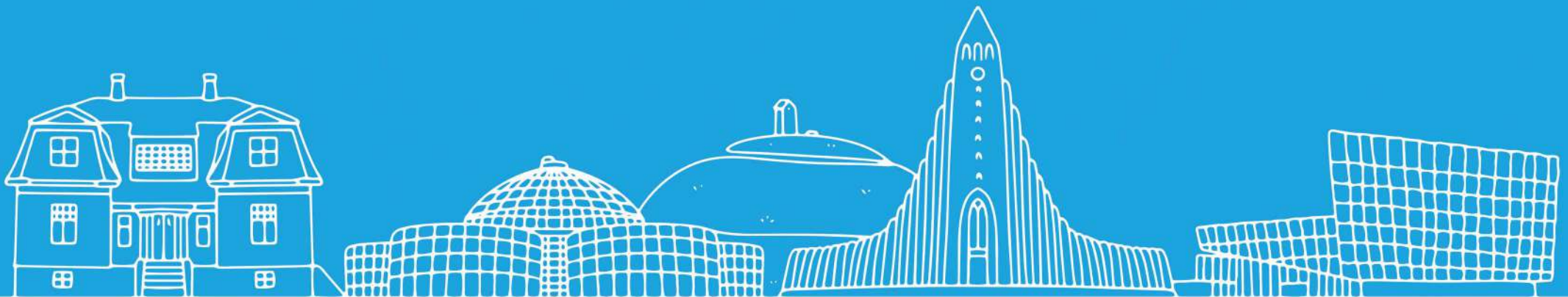

We use luxury air – conditioned coaches for the tour and the cooling may take some time as per the weather

SIGHTSEEING / ATTRACTIONS

Due to any certain unavoidable circumstances, if any activity or any sightseeing is missed then we will not be liable to pay any refunds. If any delays are caused by the passengers, the tour manager has the right to continue the tour without them and those passenger will miss out that particular sightseeing. Any loss /damage done during any activity will be borne by the passengers and we will not be liable for any loss/damages. Instructions given by the Tour Manager & Local Guide must be followed at all the times. All activates & sightseeing's are non-refundable and subject to weather conditions. we reserve the right to amend, alter, vary or withdraw any particular departure, excursion advertised. For the convenience of our passengers, we will sometimes amend the itinerary.

HEALTH & EMERGENCY DURING THE TOUR

It is presumed that the passenger who have booked the tour have gone through the itinerary & is medically fit for the tour before making any bookings. In case of any health emergency or any other related issues, the passenger shall be solely responsible to make their own travel, transfer & financial arrangements. We will not be liable for the same. In case of any guest / passenger test COVID positive before the tour date, then the cancellation will be applicable as per the cancellation policy mentioned in the itinerary. In-case any passenger is tested COVID positive during the tour / before retuning during the tour / before returning back to India then the passenger will have to be Self – Quarantine for 14days (as per the country's COVID rules) & 100% cancellation will be applicable and no refunds will be made.
