DAY 1

ARRIVAL IN AUCKLAND

—— (Meals: Dinner) ——

AUCKLAND CITY SIGHTSEEING

DAY 3

AUCKLAND – WAITOMO GLOW-WORM CAVES – HOBBITON – ROTORUA

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, check out and travel towards the world-famous Waitomo Glow-worm Caves. Enjoy a guided cave tour followed by a magical boat ride beneath thousands of naturally glowing worms, creating a spectacular star-like display. Continue your journey to Hobbiton Movie Set, the original filming location of The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit trilogies. Explore the charming Hobbit Holes, Party Tree, Green Dragon Inn, and other famous movie locations before enjoying lunch. Later, drive to Rotorua, New Zealand's geothermal wonderland, and check into your hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 4

ROTORUA SIGHTSEEING

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

Following breakfast, discover the fascinating traditions of New Zealand's indigenous Maori people during the Te Ra Guided Cultural Tour. Witness steaming geothermal landscapes, bubbling mud pools, colourful hot springs, and learn about Maori customs, history, and heritage. Later, visit the famous Agrodome Farm Show, where you'll experience entertaining sheep shearing demonstrations, working sheepdogs, and interactions with various farm animals.

Return to your hotel after a wonderful day of sightseeing.

DAY 5

ROTORUA – LAKE TAUPO – TONGARIRO NATIONAL PARK – WELLINGTON

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, depart for Wellington, New Zealand's charming capital city. En route, stop at the picturesque Lake Taupo, the country's largest freshwater lake, perfect for memorable photographs. Continue through the spectacular Tongariro National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its volcanic mountains, alpine scenery, and breathtaking landscapes. Travel along the famous Desert Road before reaching Wellington in the evening. Check into your hotel, enjoy dinner, and relax for the night. Overnight Stay: Novotel Wellington or Similar



DAY 6

WELLINGTON CITY TOUR

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

Enjoy breakfast before setting out on a guided tour of Wellington. Ride the historic Wellington Cable Car to enjoy panoramic views of the harbour and city skyline. Visit the beautiful Wellington Botanic Garden, followed by a drive past the iconic Parliament Buildings, including the famous Beehive. Later, proceed to Mount Victoria Lookout, offering breathtaking 360-degree views of Wellington Harbour, the city, and the Cook Strait. DAY 7

WELLINGTON – PICTON FERRY – KAIKOURA – CHRISTCHURCH

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, transfer to the Interislander Ferry Terminal in Wellington for one of the world's most scenic ferry crossings across the Cook Strait to Picton. Enjoy breathtaking views of the beautiful Marlborough Sounds during the journey. Upon arrival, continue by coach through the famous Marlborough wine region, known for its picturesque vineyards, followed by a scenic drive along the stunning Kaikoura coastline where the mountains meet the Pacific Ocean. Reach Christchurch by evening, check in to the hotel, enjoy dinner, and relax overnight.

DAY
8

CHRISTCHURCH – MOUNT COOK – LAKE TEKAPO – QUEENSTOWN

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, depart for Queenstown via one of New Zealand's most spectacular scenic routes. Travel across the Canterbury Plains to Aoraki/Mount Cook National Park, home to New Zealand's highest mountain. Enjoy free time for photography and lunch amidst magnificent alpine scenery. Continue to the stunning Lake Tekapo, famous for its turquoise glacial waters, and visit the iconic Church of the Good Shepherd and the Steps to Heaven viewpoint. Later, drive through the beautiful Mackenzie Basin and Crown Range before arriving in Queenstown. Check in to the hotel, followed by dinner. Overnight: Sudima Queenstown Five Mile (or Similar)



DAY 9

MILFORD SOUND EXCURSION

—— (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) ——

Enjoy breakfast before departing for a full-day excursion to the spectacular Milford Sound, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of New Zealand's greatest natural wonders. Travel through the beautiful town of Te Anau and Fiordland National Park, passing breathtaking valleys, native rainforests, and the famous Homer Tunnel. Board a scenic Milford Sound Cruise to admire towering cliffs, cascading waterfalls, and wildlife including seals, dolphins, and seasonal penguins. A light lunch will be served on board the cruise. Return to Queenstown in the evening for dinner and overnight stay.

**DAY
10**

SHOT OVER JET RIDE & LEISURE

—— (Breakfast & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, experience the thrilling Shot over Jet Boat Ride, one of Queenstown's most iconic adventure activities, featuring high-speed runs through narrow canyons and exciting 360-degree spins. The remainder of the day is free to explore Queenstown at your own pace or opt for optional activities such as the Skyline Gondola, Bungy Jumping, or a wine tour in the renowned Gibbston Valley. Dinner will be served in the evening.

Overnight: Sudima Queenstown Five Mile (or Similar)



DAY 11

QUEENSTOWN – LAKE PUKAKI – CHRISTCHURCH

—— (Breakfast & Dinner) ——

After breakfast, check out and drive back to Christchurch via the scenic Lindis Pass, known for its rolling golden landscapes and mountain views. En route, stop at the stunning Lake Pukaki to enjoy breathtaking views of the turquoise lake with Aoraki/Mount Cook in the background. Continue through the Mackenzie Basin and Canterbury countryside before arriving in Christchurch. Check in to the hotel and enjoy a farewell dinner.
